Eligibility


BSc degrees: apply in second year to study abroad for a full year in the third year. Accepted students will be transferred onto the four year degree programme BSc Natural Sciences with International Study.

MSci degrees: apply in second year to study abroad for a full year during third year of study. Students can remain on the four year degree programme with the year abroad counting towards final degree classification or choose to transfer to the five year degree programme with the year counting for progression only.

Minimum 65% average to be considered.
