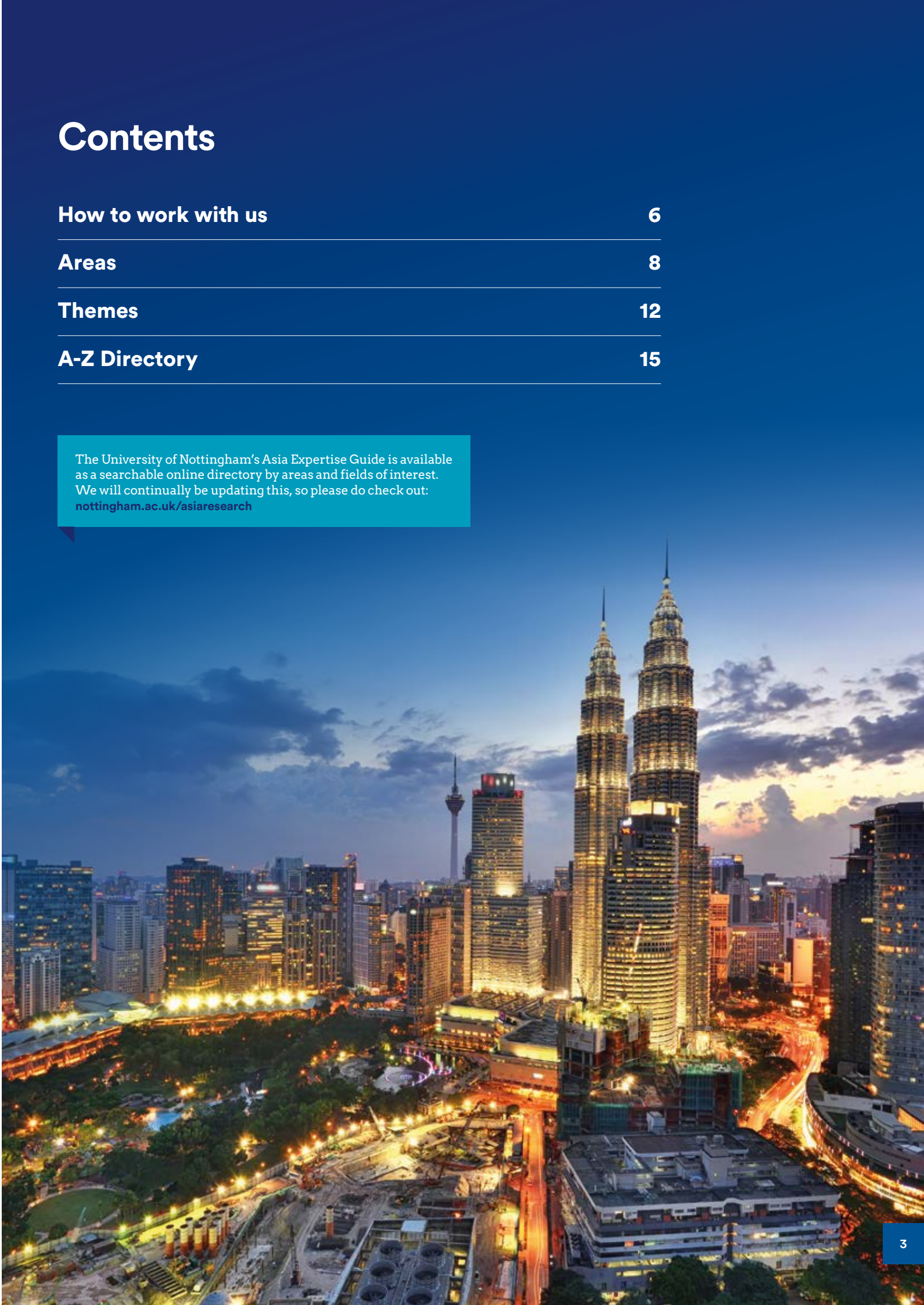

Over the last two years, the longstanding relationship between the University and the FCO helped establish an extremely popular series of seminars, roundtables and other events that brought together academic experts (from the University of Nottingham, but also our partner universities) and external stakeholders in the FCO, providing a much-needed forum for knowledge exchange and fostering evidence-based policymaking. Topics included Political and Economic Implications of the Belt and Road Initiative; China, Taiwan and Regional Security; the Future of UK-China Relations after Brexit and China's conception of the rule of law and its impact on market governance.



Nottingham Health China Partnership

Working with the Faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences and the University of Nottingham Ningbo China Campus, ABC successfully established a strategic platform, which helps UK business and clinical practitioners work with Chinese hospitals and healthcare professionals to address the healthcare challenges in the country.
