

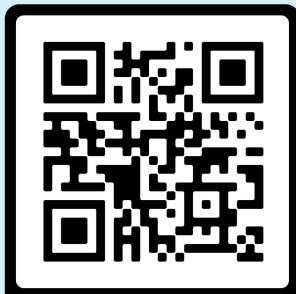

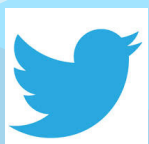

About AlSingace

- Professor of mechanical engineering imprisoned in Bahrain since 2011 for peaceful pro-democracy protests
- **Tortured** upon arrest, had glasses and crutches confiscated for weeks, endured physical, sexual and mental abuse.
- He is disabled and **deplorable mistreatment** by Jau prison has seriously worsened his pre-existing health condition
- On Hunger strike since **8th July 2021**, protesting the confiscation of his apolitical research and continued mistreatment in prison, including **denial of basic healthcare**

Our Campaign

- Ultimately calling for his **unconditional release**
- Help **end his hunger strike** by getting the Bahrain government and prison to:
- return his confiscated research and book, that he wrote in prison, to his family
 - **reinstate his full visitation rights**
 - provide adequate healthcare including necessary MRI scans and pain medication
 - Ensure dignity of prisoners by ending abuse by guards

Effects of hunger strike

After 2 WEEKS, a person can experience dizziness, weakness, loss of concentration and low heart rate

After 1 MONTH, the body undergoes irreversible damage - loss of vision, difficulty in hearing and swallowing

AFTER 45 DAYS, **DEATH IS A REAL RISK**
