

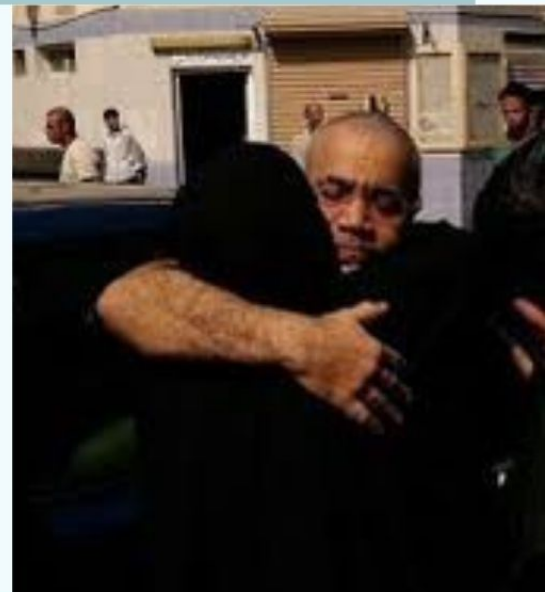
WHY SHOULD YOU CARE?



- Dr Al-Singace has continuously spoken up for human rights in Bahrain throughout his life and was unjustly imprisoned after taking part in a pro-democracy protest.
- He has reported inhumane conditions in prison, including harassment by guards, sexual assault, being placed in what is effectively solitary confinement and denied of visits from his family.
- He has been denied healthcare despite having post-polio syndrome as well as other pre-existing health conditions.
- In 2021, he began a hunger strike, protesting his ill-treatment in Jau prison and the confiscation of an academic book he had spent 4 years working.
- Dr Al-Singace has been in this position for 13 years and nothing has changed. He continues to face ill-treatment in prison and has now been on hunger strike for 2.5 years. His health is deteriorating and urgent action is needed to save his life.

WE ARE DEMANDING...

- **Improvement to his conditions in Jau Prison, including the proper provision of healthcare, in line with Bahrain's international obligations.**
- **His immediate release and for any charges or convictions relating to his peaceful exercise of human rights to be lifted.**
