

SB Campus Walk

Walk Distance: 2.5 – 3 km Walk Time: 30-40 minutes

Start at the covered area, near the fountains. Walk towards the Library (34) skirting around to the right of the building and out on the front lawns. The Main Building (11) was built in 1915 as Midland Dairy & Agricultural College, it was requisitioned as a POW camp for officers in WWI.

Take a left at the start of the accommodation block (H) and walk towards The Barn (20). Turn right passing accommodation block (I) before reaching Bonington's Farm Shop and Café (17).

Walk through the car park and across the road that leads to Vet School (27) and CLV reception (A). Walk down the left side of Gateway building (29) this was built of straw from the UoN farm, Sir Peter Rubin Centre (36) is viewable to your right. Turn left follow the path between Hounsfield Facility (32) and South Lab (18). You will see a lime tree avenue, planted to commemorate students and staff who died in WWI.

Take a left on the path and via right past Food Sciences (14), Plant Sciences (8) and BaBs (7). Turn right past the glasshouses on the left to the T junction and turn left. UoN farmland is to your right. Turn left onto a gravelled road, passing the chicken coop, through a carpark and past the SB Society allotments, towards accommodation block (M). Looking right you will see the entrance to the arboretum (39). This optional loop has various paths, walkable dependent upon weather conditions see Arboretum tree map.

Follow the road back, past the Hopper bus stop, North Lab (5), Lecture Block (9) to the covered area where you started. ©
