

CENTRAL BUILDING

Dear Neighbour,

We write to provide you with an update for the redevelopment of the Central Building for the University of Nottingham.

The new HV power sub stations are now under construction and will shortly be commencing new power supplies within the trench ducting between the associated buildings.



Internally, we are preparing the building for the removal of the fabric roof. This includes carrying out structural temporary works and the removal of fragile and vulnerable elements of the existing building in anticipation for the fabric roof works to commence at the end of April.

Drainage and structural concrete works are also being carried out inside the building to suit the new internal building layout.

The front and back rear glass elevations are now being removed and stored to facilitate the roof replacement.



All structural review, assessments and analysis surveys are now complete, which form the methodology of the replacement works.

Restoration works to the Listed concrete slabs are underway, with specialist contractors carefully removing years of paint and debris, bringing the structure back to its original state, in order to restore and preserve the building's retained features.





The former changing rooms have now been stripped out and the existing 10 dual sided benches have been donated to local football club - Pelican Colts, giving them a new home.

We recently welcomed two Year 10 work experience students from Bemrose School and Lees Brook Academy. Both students worked alongside our project team, including our Project Manager, Site Manager, Quantity Surveyor, Design Manager and Engineer.

The students worked with the team, to gain on site skills and experience and the chance to find out what roles are available for a career in construction.

They have also been offered the opportunity to return to site for a time convenient to them, to gain further on site experience.
