What happens?

The programme takes places across four half-days online, each involving up to 4 hours of engagement.

During the programme, you explore a major world challenge, "How do we ensure our cities are resilient and inclusive for a post-pandemic world?", from a global perspective.

You engage with visionary leaders from local and global businesses, governments and not-for-profit organisations, whose insights will further your understanding of the challenge, and help you find creative ways to solve it.

Throughout the programme, you participate in a combination of full-group sessions and small breakout sessions, where you build connections with your peers, from your University, University of Birmingham and the global Universitas 21 network.
