



## **Button Guide**

### **Contents button**

The contents button opens a vertical menu listing every page in the learning resource. The current page that is open will be highlighted and the menu can be closed by clicking the contents button once again.

### **Previous and Next buttons**

The Previous and Next buttons appear at the top and bottom of each page of the learning resource and allow you to navigate to the previous and next page.

### **Supporting Text button**

The Supporting Text button allows you to remove text from a page if that is your preference. Each page of the resource has text on the left hand side and activities or pictures on the right hand side. If you prefer to listen to the text rather than read it you can simply hide the text and control the narration with the narration button. The Supporting Text button is not accessible on every page and will be greyed out when it cannot be used.

### **Text Size button**

The Text Size buttons change the size of the text. The button with the plus sign on it will make the text bigger and the button with the minus sign on it will make the text smaller. Subsequent clicks on these buttons will make the text bigger or smaller.

### **Narration button**

The Narration buttons controls much of the audio in the resource. When a new page opens the text on the right hand side can be heard by a narrator. This narration which accompanies each page begins automatically. If you wish to turn this narration off you can click on the pause button which will then change to a play button. Then if you wish to resume the narration you

can now click on the play button. To the right of the pause button there is a replay button which when clicked will begin the narration from the beginning.

### **Progress bar**

The progress bar positioned at the bottom of each page shows the learner the progress they are making through the resource. If for example the learner was on a page half-way through the resource the progress bar on that page would be half-full. At the end of the resource the progress bar is completely full to show the resource has been completed.
