William Bradbury by his bond, shown in court dated Fri after the feast of the conversion of St Paul 4 Henry V [29 Jan 1417], acknowledged himself firmly bound to John and William Sherman in 5m 10s., to be paid on the feast of the purification of the BVM [2 Feb] 1419. Afterwards William Bradbury appointed Margery and Agnes as executors of his will and died. After his death Margery and Agnes declined (*recusant*) and still decline. Damages: 40s. They produce suit. Richard and Margery say that William, the testator, mortgaged to Robert Boteller of Granby a murrey and 6 silver spoons for 40s. until a certain day and forfeited. After the testator's death, at the request of Margery, Robert mortgaged (*impigniavit*) the murrey and spoons to Alan Smyth of Nottingham, chaplain, for the said 40s. They are still in Alan's hands for 40s. because Margery administered the murrey and spoons. Furthermore, Richard and Margery say that before the day of impetration of this suit Margery [administered] all the testator's goods and chattels except 2 robes worth ½m, a tunic worth 20d., a lined cloak (*armilausam duplicat*) with a hood which are for Margery's use, and a silver girdle. Richard and Margery put themselves on the country. John and William Shermon say that Richard and Margery say that the testator in his lifetime mortgaged a murrey and 6 silver spoons to Robert Boteller of Granby for 40s. as above. After the testator's death, at the request of the same Margery, Robert mortgaged them to Alan Smyth of Nottingham, chaplain, for 40s. and furthermore that Margery mortgaged all the testator's goods and chattels before the day of impetration of the suit except 2 robes worth ½m, a tunic worth 20d. and a lined cloak with hood which are for Margery's use, and a silver girdle, saying that Robert never mortgaged to Alan the murrey and spoons nor Margery administered all the testator's goods and chattels before the day of impetration of the suit as above, but all the other goods and chattels are which Margery never administered beyond the said goods and chattels which Richard and Margery acknowledge by their own recognition.
