

How to check if I can take a Language Centre module

1. Go to "Services for Students" Module enrolment page and click on the link to the "Curriculum Catalogue" at the bottom of the page.



2. Once you've logged in with your university log in details, click on whichever programme catalogue applies to your campus.

3. Using the drop-down menu, select the correct year, and then either type in the name of your course, or the code (if known).
