Modern slavery referrals from small boat crossings

*I request that you provide me with data on the total number of referrals made either through the National Referral Mechanism (NRM) or the Duty to Notify (MS1) process for those that have arrived in the UK via small boats crossings between 01 January 2021 and 10 December 2021.

The following information should also be provided for each of the referral within this category:

- > Nationality of the potential victim identified;
- > Whether the potential victim was an adult or a child;
- Gender of potential victims identified;
- > The First Responder agency making the referral

Key takeaways

- In 2021, 28,526 migrants are known to have crossed the English Channel in small boats. Of these, 1,099 were referred to the NRM = 4% of the total
- Of the 1,099 referred, 956 (87%) were adults and 143 (13%) were children
- The most common nationality of those referred was Vietnamese (n361 = 33%), Sudanese (n144 = 13%), Eritrean (n133 =12%), Iranian (112 = 10%) and Albanian (n108 = 10%)
- Of the 1,099 referred into the NRM, 990 were male and 109 were female
- UK Visas & Immigration made 54% of these NRM referrals, followed by UK Immigration Enforcement (22%) and Local Authority staff (9%). The remaining referrals were made by NGOs who are designated First Responders, the police and UK Border Force.
