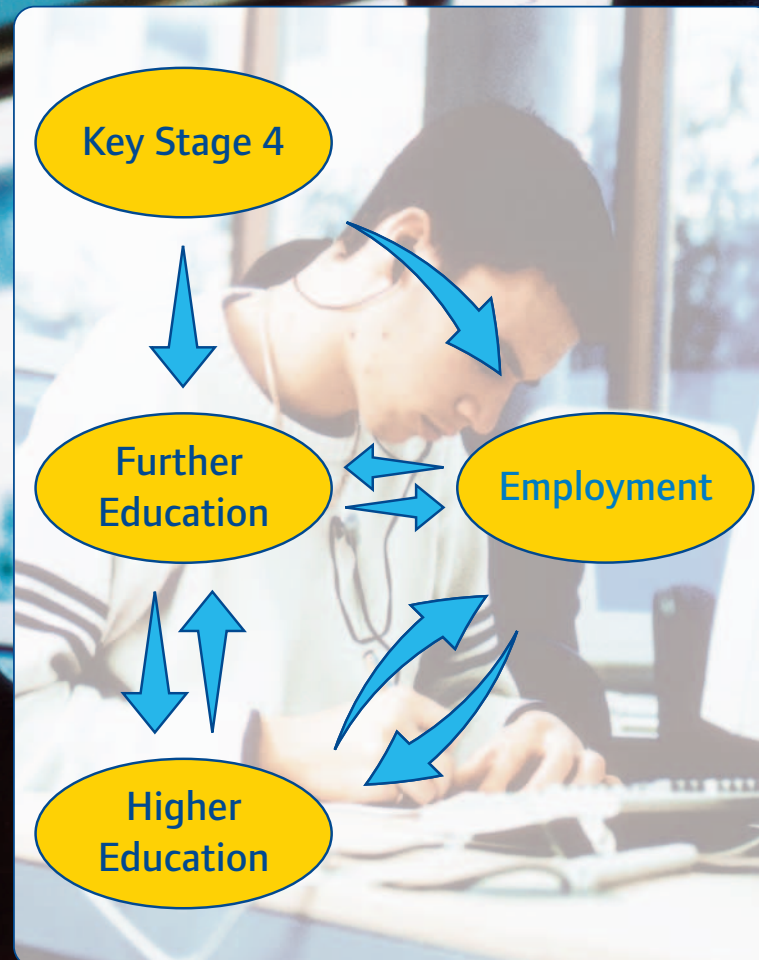
OUTPUTS
