Footwear and uniforms for clinical placements

As a student nurse, you will need to wear your uniform on placement according to university and trust policy, which you will find out more about once you have commenced the course. You will be measured for a uniform and ordered one in the first few weeks of the course.

You will need to provide your own placement-appropriate shoes, which need to be flat, leather-type supportive shoes with no-slip heels and soles. The shoe should cover the whole foot including the forefoot and mid-foot.

You can purchase these shoes before you arrive or once you have started the course. Please see some examples of appropriate shoes below.







You will also need to purchase a polo shirt to be worn in clinical skills sessions on the online store, which you can find here: <u>School of Health Sciences Online Store</u>

This shirt must be worn during clinical skill sessions where indicated by your course or field lead.
