The University of Nottingham Rugby League club is made up of a 1st and 2nd team, with a club membership base of 60 students, and a growing Women's team. In the 2024/25 season, our 1st team will be competing in Tier 1 (South), and our 2nd team in Tier 2 (South), with the 1st Team looking to secure promotion into the newly formed National League.

We have achieved recent successes in reaching the BUCS Cup final (2022/23), as well as back-to-back Varsity wins, and intend to continue our strong set of results in the upcoming season.

We require a coach to deliver the Rugby League programme in line with the UoN Vision for Sport that ensures sustained performance success and outstanding student experience. The head coach will lead and deliver performance programmes for the 2024/2025 BUCS season. This includes planning and delivery of training, coaching on selected match days, supporting the recruitment of athletes and club development.
