Online Module Enrolment Timeline

April-May

This is pre-enrolment when you choose your modules for the next academic year. Selecting your modules at this time gives you the maximum chance of securing your modules of choice, you will see your individual timetable as soon as it is released and be able to access moodle when it is available nearer to the start of the relevant semester. This gives you the opportunity to plan your year ahead.

May-July

Registry & Academic Affairs check all module choices and allocate spaces on modules working to defined criteria. We will only contact students at this point where there is a problem with a module choice such as the module doesn't fit with your plan, the module is full etc.

August

Registration opens and students will be able to see their core modules and those who have chosen optional modules during pre-enrolment will be able to see these as well on the NottinghamHub.

Early September

Individual timetables are now available for returning students but will only show core modules for those that did not choose modules in the pre-enrolment period. Students who took advantage of the pre-enrolment period will see both core and optional choices.

Late September

You will have the opportunity to change any of your optional modules if you wish during the change of mind period. You should bear in mind that any changes to your module choices now may affect your timetable as not all module combinations are possible. Changing modules during this period increases the chances of having clashed teaching or an uneven schedule and can take up to 72 hours to show on individual timetables.

New students make their choices at the start of semester.

January - start of Spring semester

You will have a further opportunity to change your Spring semester modules only during the January change of mind period. Again, any changes at this point may lead to clashes in your timetable.
