Revised Terms of Reference

To keep under review the activities of I.R.D. and S.P.A.(Prop) and to consider the draft annual Estimates for the I.R.D. and S.P.A. (Prop) elements\* in the Secret Vote in the light of:-

- (a) geographical priorities
- (b) Functional priorities
- (c) The total desirable ceiling relative to other information and overseas expenditure.
- (d) the relative value of the different kinds of unavowable information activities

and to advise the Permanent Secretaries Committee on these aspects.

2. To examine any new large I.R.D. or S.P.A. (Prop) project likely to cost in the aggregate more than £50,000 and to submit it with their recommendations to the Permanent Under-Secretary of the Foreign Office and the Secretary of the Cabinet (Sir Burke Trend)

\*N.B. In order to consider overall incidence of expenditure in the light of regional priorities, I.R.D. and S.P.A. (Prop) activities and Estimates should be considered at the same time.
