The Questionnaire is to be considered at the next meeting of the Counter-Subversion Committee on Tuesday, October 23. The present state of preparation is as follows.

2. Of the original four "pilot scheme" papers - Iran, Finland, Indonesia and Venezuela, which it was agreed should be attempted by IRD;

- a) Iran - is completed with all comments incorporated in a final paper. Our Friends' comments on the paper on Assessment of the Threat are now being incorporated.
- b) Finland - is being considered by our Friends.
- c) Indonesia - is being considered by our Friends.
- d) Venezuela - completed draft is ready to go to Caracas.

3. Further papers undertaken by IRD are;

- a) Lebanon - is being considered in Beirut.
- b) Sudan - is being considered by our Friends'
- c) Kuwait - IRD await comment from our Friends.
- d) Libya - IRD await comment from our Friends.
- e) Bolivia - IRD await comment from our Friends.
- f) Guinea - IRD await comment from our Friends.
- g) Capetown - is being completed in final draft by IRD.
- h) Burma - have completed the questionnaire - IRD.
- i) Nigeria - Lagos have completed the questionnaire. This is being compared with IRD's draft in Commonwealth Relations Office.
- j) Ghana - is being considered in Accra.

4. Suggested priorities for future study are;

- a) Cyprus.
- b) Zanzibar.
- c) Mauritius - suggested at the last meeting of the Counter-Subversion Committee.

5. Priorities for further studies of Foreign Office territories are under discussion with our Friends.
