## Forest Recreation Ground (for Goose Fair)

- Board any **Orange** or **Pink** bus to **City**
- Change at **Victoria Centre** and catch any **Purple, Lime, Yellow** or **Brown** bus
- Get off at **Forest Rec Ground**



## City Hospital

- Board any **Orange** bus to **City**
- Change at **Queen's Medical Centre** and catch **53, 54** to **Arnold**
- Get off at **City Hospital**



## National Water Sports Centre

- Board any **Orange** or **Pink** bus to **City**
- Change at **Victoria Centre** and catch **11C**
- Get off at **National Water Sports Centre**
