



## **PATHOLOGY PROCEDURES AND FEES (From 01 February 2022)**

Standard companion animal necropsy prices include: Gross post-mortem and histopathologic examination (H&E), basic disposal costs and reporting. The pathology service of the School of Veterinary Medicine and Science is an academic teaching unit and involves undergraduate and postgraduate teaching in veterinary pathology. All fees are therefore subsidised by the University. Cases which exclude student involvement on request of the referring vet will incur higher costs. Further tests including bacteriology and services external to the SVMS will be charged accordingly, subject to prior agreement with the referring vet. Value Added Tax is added at current rate to all fees. A preliminary report will be submitted within two working days (usually per phone) and a final written report (by email) within 4 to 6 working weeks. ### **Dogs, Cats**

Small dogs or cats (<10kg)	£180 + VAT
Medium sized (10-25kg)	£205 + VAT
Large dogs (25-50kg)	£255 + VAT
Giant dogs (>50kg)	£310 + VAT
GBGB greyhound protocol	£310 + VAT

### **Horses or large animals**

Fetus-6 months (or < 100kg)	£360 + VAT
6 months-adult (or > 100kg)	£595 + VAT

**Small mammals** £180 + VAT

Surcharge for legal cases	£250
Surcharge for CNS cases	£100
Surcharge for zoonotic cases	£100

Holding charge for cases £50 per month per case. This charge will come into effect 2 months after the report has been sent.

### **Surgical Biopsy- Histopathology (Price covers routine H&E staining)**

Single tissue (1-3 slides)	£35 + VAT
Two tissues, same animal or large sample > 5cm ø (or 4-10 slides/sample)	£45 + VAT
For every additional tissue sample	£15 + VAT
Professional interpretation of referral slides	£25 +VAT
