

Veterinary Pathology Service Pricing and Procedures

Our service

Our companion animal post-mortem prices include: gross (visual) post-mortem and histopathologic examination (H&E), basic disposal costs and reporting. The Pathology Service of the School of Veterinary Medicine and Science is an academic teaching unit that involves undergraduate and postgraduate teaching in veterinary pathology. The University, therefore, subsidises all fees. Cases that exclude student involvement at the request of the referring vet will incur higher costs. Further tests, including bacteriology and services external to the SVMS, will be charged accordingly, subject to prior agreement with the referring vet. Value Added Tax is added at the current rate to all fees. A preliminary report will be submitted within two working days (usually by telephone), and a final written report (by email) within 4 to 6 working weeks.
